Bridge girders for I-10 Twin Peaks overpass to be delivered this week

TUCSON – The first delivery of concrete bridge girders for the I-10 Twin Peaks overpass will be delivered to the project construction site Nov. 19 and 20. Each girder is 120 feet long and will require its own transport truck and two pilot vehicles.

Deliveries are scheduled to begin at 5 a.m. on both days with 15-minute intervals between each delivery. The scheduled delivery route is as follows:

- Trucks will be coming from Phoenix using eastbound I-10. Trucks will continue their route on eastbound I-10 past the current road closure barricades and travel directly into the construction site.

The Department of Public Safety will assist in directing the trucks along their routes.

While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project unscheduled closures or restrictions may occur. ADOT appreciates the driving public's patience as it constructs these improvements.

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
