### **Santa Cruz River Multi-Use Path Closed at Twin Peaks Road**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) has begun the first phase of construction on Marana's \$50.5 million Twin Peaks Interchange.

During this phase, the Santa Cruz River Multi-Use Path will be closed at Twin Peaks Road while crews prepare for the extension of Twin Peaks Road across the Santa Cruz River.

The Santa Cruz River Multi-Use Path will remain open at all other locations during this time. Users are asked to use other trailheads located at: Sanders Road, Postvale Road, Marana Heritage River Park, Gladden Farms Community Park, Wade McClean Park and El Rio Park.

ADOT and Pulice Construction want to ensure the safety of all pedestrians and bicyclists during this phase of construction. Please be aware of construction signage, vehicles and personnel while traveling along the multi-use path.

ADOT appreciates your patience and cooperation as we work to construct the interchange.
