Construction vehicles using Eastbound Frontage Road as haul route

The Arizona Department of Transportation has made significant strides toward completing the much anticipated Interstate 10 - Twin Peaks Interchange. The following are upcoming traffic restrictions:

In February, construction vehicles will be using the left lane along the Eastbound Frontage Road from Tiffany Loop to Avra Valley Road as a two-way haul route. During this time, the right lane along eastbound frontage road will remain a one-way eastbound-only route for all non-construction related vehicles.

ADOT advises drivers to proceed with caution, obey all posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel. Please do not follow construction vehicles into the work zone.

While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project unscheduled closures or restrictions might occur. ADOT appreciates the driving public's patience as it constructs these improvements.
