Traffic Signal Activated at Twin Peaks Road and Coachline Boulevard Intersection in Continental Ranch

MARANA – This Friday, ADOT will activate a new traffic signal in the Continental Ranch subdivision at the intersection of Twin Peaks Road and Coachline Boulevard. For the first 48 hours, the signal light will be set to flash mode to let motorists in the area become accustomed to the newly signalized intersection.

Prior to the installation of the traffic signal, this intersection has operated as a four-way-stop. During this traffic control change, motorists traveling in the area are advised to use caution and obey all new traffic control signals, markings and signage.

To ensure the safety of area elementary school students, ADOT and Marana committed early in the project to have this intersection operational prior to the start of the new school year in August. This project will also provide new crosswalks along Twin Peaks Road, to accommodate students and other pedestrians in the intersection and roadway.

This improvement is being made possible as part of the Twin Peaks Interchange Project, a partnership among the Arizona Department of Transportation, Town of Marana, and the Regional Transportation Authority.

While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project unscheduled closures or restrictions might occur. ADOT appreciates the driving public's patience as it constructs these improvements.
