### **Traffic Signal Work Requires Lane Closures Along Twin Peaks Road and Silverbell Road in Continental Ranch**

Beginning Monday, construction crews will be conducting traffic signal work at the Twin Peaks Road/Coachline Boulevard and Silverbell Road/Twin Peaks Road intersections in the Continental Ranch area. Work will require right lane closures when crews are present at the intersections.

Work will take place from 5 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday; crews anticipate completion by July 16. Once work is complete, the Town of Marana will take steps to activate the signals and make both intersections fully operational.

This improvement is being made possible as part of the Twin Peaks Interchange Project, which is a partnership among the Arizona Department of Transportation, Town of Marana and the Regional Transportation Authority.

ADOT advises drivers to proceed with caution, obey all posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel. Please do not follow construction vehicles into the work zone.
