**UPDATE -- Eastbound I-10 traffic switch this weekend**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is continuing construction along Interstate 10 and the eastbound frontage road.

**The following traffic impacts and activities will take place from Friday, Jan. 15 at 10 p.m. through Monday, Jan. 18 at 5 a.m.**

**Westbound I-10:**

**LANE CLOSURE:** Westbound I-10 will be reduced to one lane from Cortaro Road to Avra Valley Road (milepost 246 to 242).

**ON-RAMP CLOSURE:** Westbound I-10 on-ramp at Cortaro Road will be closed. Traffic will be detoured onto the eastbound frontage road to use the Ina Road westbound I-10 on-ramp.

**Eastbound I-10:**

**LANE CLOSURE:** Eastbound I-10 will be reduced to one lane from Avra Valley Road to Cortaro Road (milepost 242 to 246).

**ON-RAMP CLOSURE:** Eastbound I-10 on-ramp at Avra Valley Road will be closed. Traffic will be detoured onto the eastbound frontage road to use the Cortaro Road eastbound I-10 on-ramp.

*ADOT advises drivers to proceed with caution, obey all posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel.*

*While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project unscheduled closures or restrictions might occur. ADOT appreciates the driving public's patience as it constructs these improvements.*
