Traffic Signal Loop Detector Installation

On Monday, June 21, construction crews will install traffic detectors at the intersection of Twin Peaks and Coachline and Twin Peaks and Silverbell Road. Minor lane closures will be necessary to complete the work. Crews will be on site from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

On Tuesday, June 22, crews will install traffic detectors at the intersections of Silverbell Road and Coachline and Silverbell Road and Wade in Continental Ranch. Minor lane closures will be necessary to complete the work. Crews will be on site from 8 p.m. to 2 a.m. the following morning.

All other intersections within the Continental Ranch area have been previously upgraded with traffic detectors; this is the last intersection requiring an upgrade. The traffic signals installed at the intersections of Twin Peaks Road/Silverbell Road and Twin Peaks Road/Coachline Boulevard are also equipped with this technology.

This improvement is being made possible as part of the Twin Peaks Interchange Project, a partnership among the Arizona Department of Transportation, Town of Marana, and the Regional Transportation Authority.

ADOT advises drivers to proceed with caution, obey all posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel. Please do not follow construction vehicles into the work zone.

While ADOT strives to inform the public about planned roadway restrictions, during any complex construction project unscheduled closures or restrictions might occur. ADOT appreciates the driving public's patience as it constructs these improvements.
